PhD, Professor of Leadership, Henley Business School

Peter is one of the Global top 100 coaches and the international thought leader in systemic coaching, executive teams, and board development. He is an Emeritus Professor of Leadership at Henley Business School, Honorary President of the Association of Executive Coaching and Chairman of Renewal Associates and joint founder and Dean of the Global Team Coaching Institute.

He has been a keynote speaker at many international conferences on learning organization, leadership, and executive coaching and teaches and leads masterclasses in Systemic Team Coaching in over 50 different countries.

He is the author of many best-selling books and papers in the fields of leadership, board and team coaching, systemic coaching, supervision, and organizational transformation (including Leadership Team Coaching, 2021 (4th ed); Leadership Team Coaching in Practice, 2022 (3rd ed); Ecological and Climate Conscious Coaching 2022, with Alison Whybrow, Eve Turner and Josie Mclean; Systemic Coaching (2020, with Eve Turner); Supervision in the Helping Professions (2020, with Aisling McMahon) and Integrative Psychotherapy (2020, with Judy Ryde); Coaching, Mentoring and Organizational Consultancy: Supervision, Skills and Development (2013, with Nick Smith); Creating a Coaching Culture, 2012; and The Wise Fool's Guide to Leadership, O Books, 2005.

Peter was joint founder, in 1986, of Bath Consultancy Group and its chairman until the company was sold in 2010 and has chaired three other company boards as well as being a trustee director of several charities. Peter Hawkins has consulted to a wide range of governments, and leading commercial, financial and professional organizations including Fortune 500 and FtSE 100 international companies. He now supervises and mentors many coaching and consultancy businesses internationally as well as running international trainings and masterclasses.

He lives on the edge of Bath, UK with 37 acres which he shares, with many animals and trees as well as his children and grandchildren and leaders who come on courses and retreats.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will Supervision form part of the program?

Group supervision will be included in every module as part of your practicums at no extras cost. Any individual or pair supervision would be an additional cost. A list of approved supervisors will be available to students who would like to arrange individual or pair supervision.

Is Senior Practitioner accredited by the EMCC Global and ICF?

The program will be accredited at Team Coaching Senior Practitioner Level by EMCC Global and is therefore a key step in becoming individually accredited at ITCA Senior Practitioner level. However, please note that EMCC accreditation is entirely optional and will need to be applied for separately. The program will also be linked to ICF accreditation and CCE units (still to be clarified with ICF)

Can I do the Senior Practitioner Program if I have completed the PERILL or CASP Practitioner Program? Will there be any additional support to help me prepare?

You may enroll for the Senior Practitioner program if you graduated from the PERILL Practitioner 2020/21 or CASP Practitioner 2022 GTCI Programs. We will provide you with a recommended program of reading and preparation to do ahead of the program start to ensure you are aligned.

How many of the Modules will Peter Hawkins be directly involved in?

Peter Hawkins will be personally leading 4 of the 12 modules. Working very closely with Colm Murphy, Peter has also contributed to design of the other 8 modules.



Frequently Asked Questions

What will I learn on Senior Practitioner that I didn't learn on Practitioner?

This program is for experienced team coaches who have already coached teams and are now learning to coach across the boundaries. Senior Practitioner focuses on the final three steps in the team coaching pyramid; enabling the team to coach itself; coaching the "team of team"; and developing an integrated teaming culture right across an enterprise.

What business benefit will I get from Senior Practitioner?

You will learn how to deliver team coaching engagements, over several years in the same organization, to a number of teams while also coaching the connections between these teams and between the organization and its stakeholders.

What are the joining requirements?

To be accepted on this program, you will need to evidence in your application form

- Experience in coaching teams
- You have completed at least one team coaching project recently that lasted for at least 6 months
- Have a live case team to work with throughout GTCI Senior Practitioner from April 2023.
 This team must be sourced by participants by Module 2 in April 2023.
- Have completed the GTCI Practitioner program (Systemic, STC, PERILL or CASP stream),
 AOEC / Renewal Associates Systemic Team Coaching © Certificate or Diploma,
 or equivalent EMCC Global Team Coaching Practitioner level program.

With a limit of 240 places, preference will be given to GTCI Practitioner alumni, and after that, to those with extensive team coaching experience.



Frequently Asked Questions

How do I apply?

Provided you have met all the criteria above, you will need to complete and submit an application form to guarantee your place. Once your application has been processed you will receive a response and, if offered a place, then you will be sent details on how to make payment to secure your place.

How much does the program cost and what payment plans do you offer?

If you enroll by 1st March 2023 you will pay the Early Bird discount rate of \$5,995. After that, the full price will be payable at \$6,995.

You may pay in full upfront or in 4 installments. Should you wish to pay in installments then you can pay in 4 payments of \$1,525 if you purchase the Early Bird offer, or \$1,775 if at the full rate. The 1st payment upfront will secure your place. The 2nd payment will be due in June 2023, 3rd payment in October 2023 and the final payment by end of November 2023.

What payment methods do you accept?

Payments can be made by bank transfer to a US or UK bank. You may also pay by credit card.

Do you have a refund policy?

Refunds will only be possible if requested 30 days before the program start date of 17th April 2023. It will be helpful to provide as much notice as possible to allow more time to fill the space.
